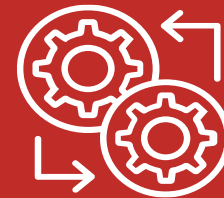

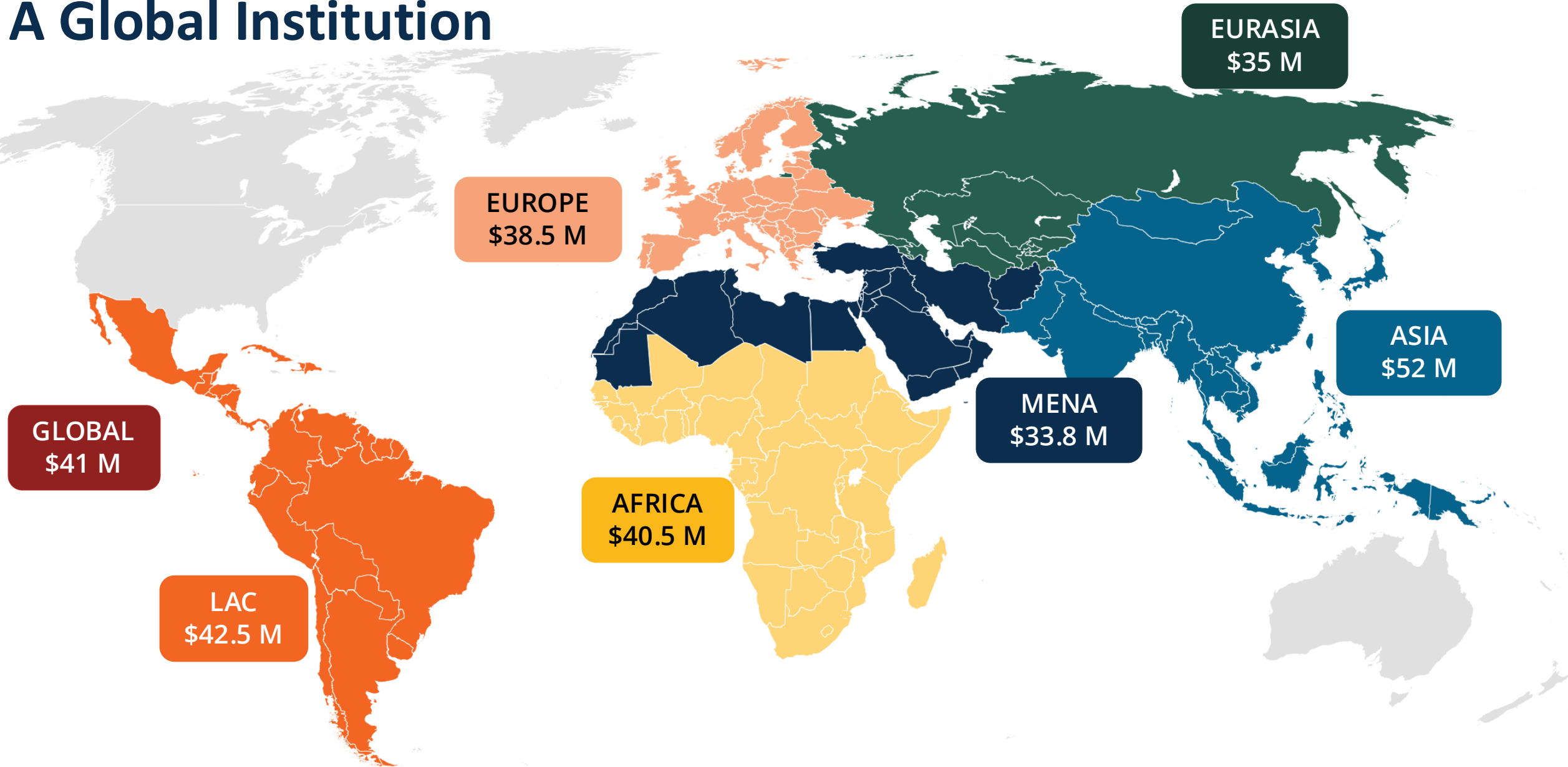

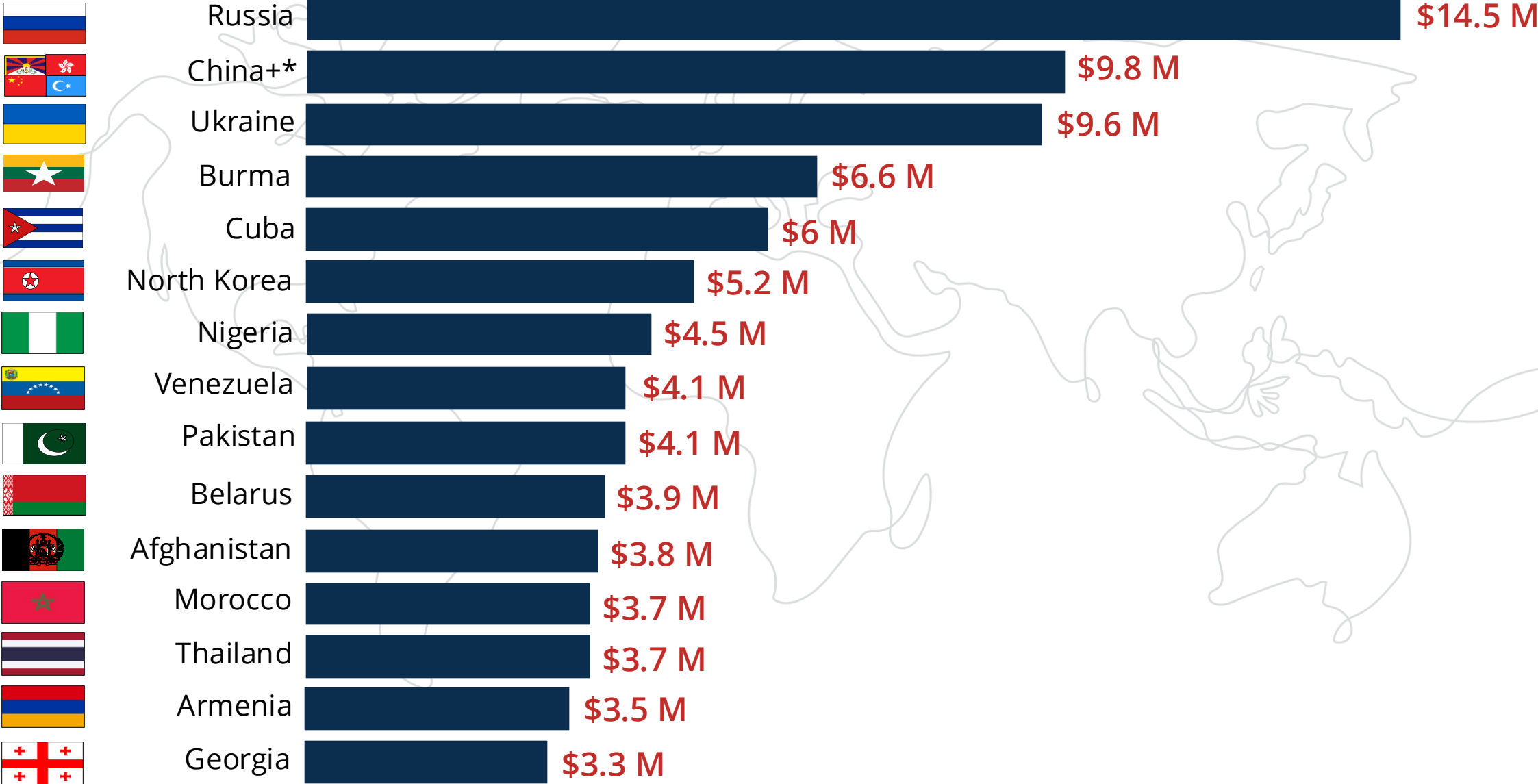

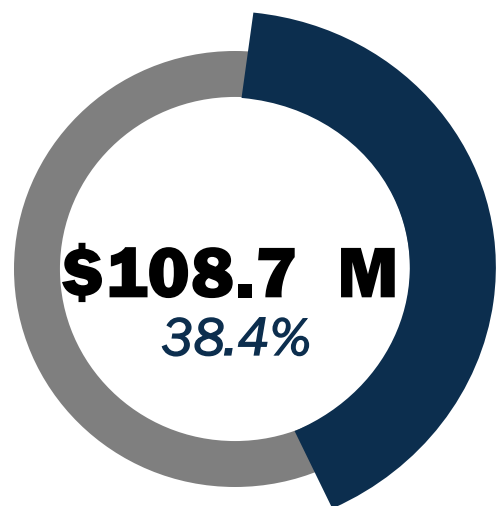
FY23 Top 15 Country Portfolios



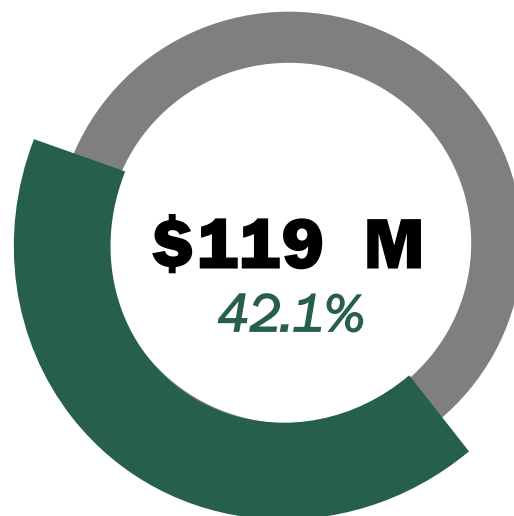

FY23 Investment by Freedom House Ranking

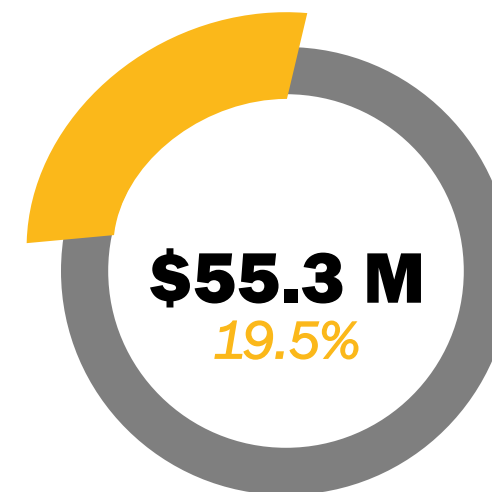

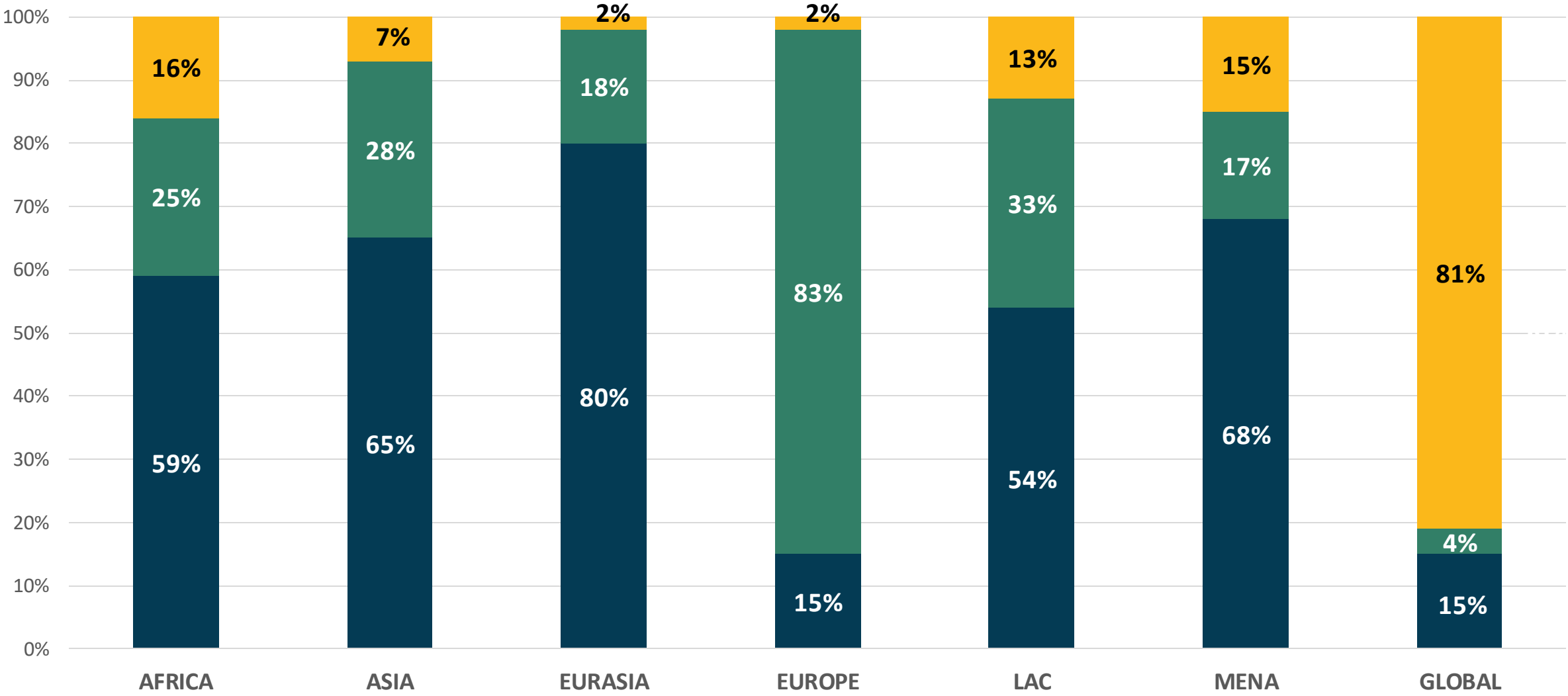

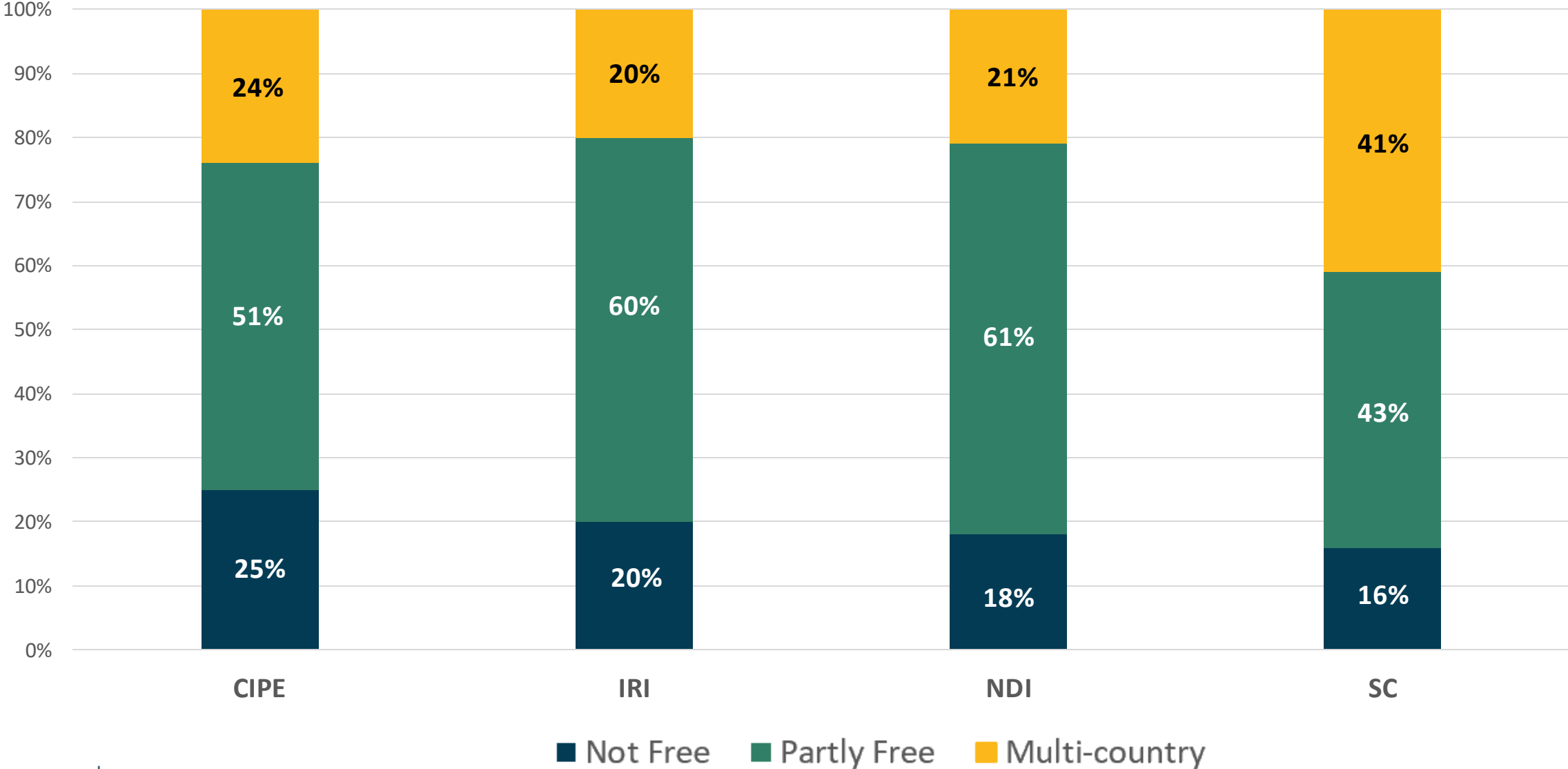

■ Not Free ■ Partly Free ■ Multi-country

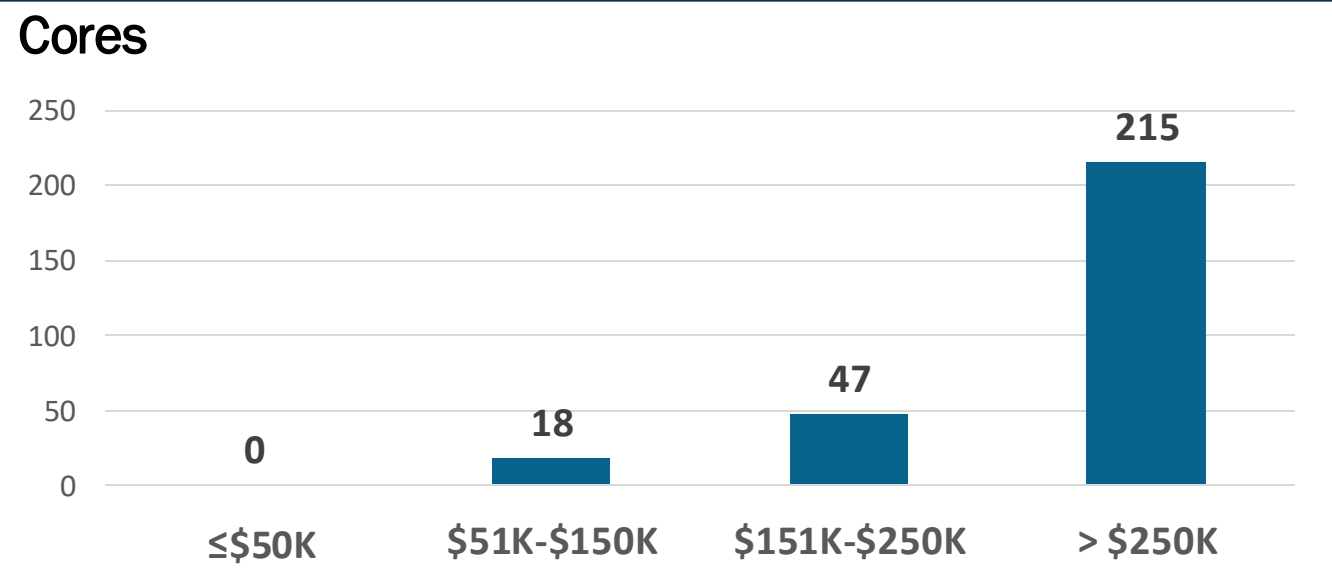
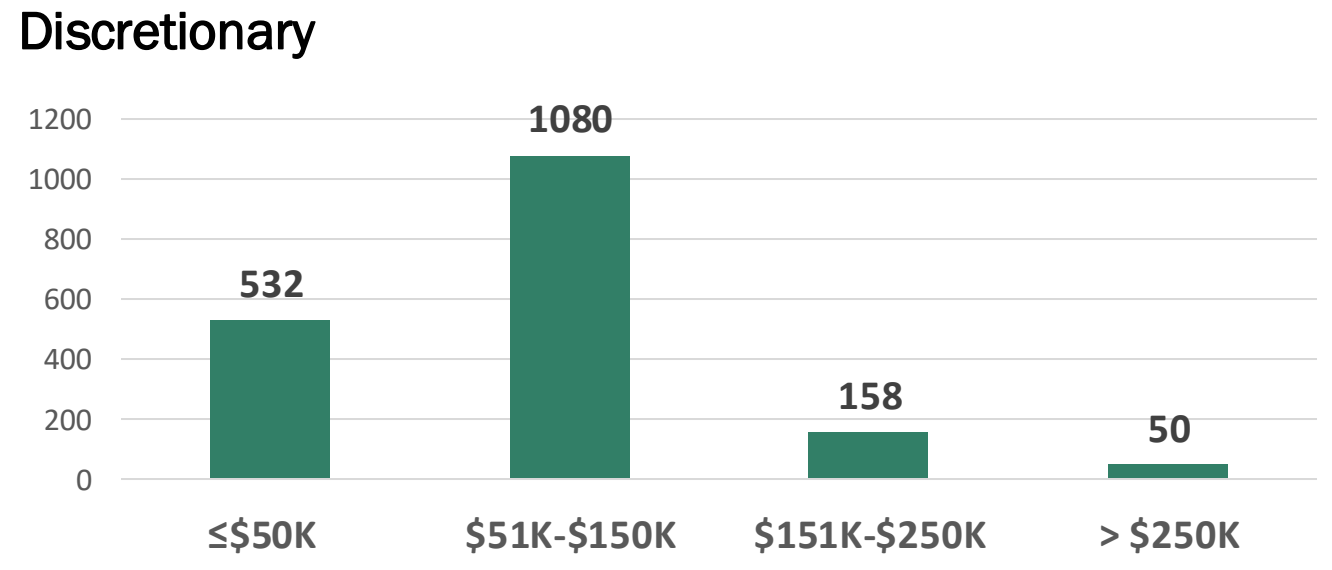
FY23 Cores Investment by FH Ranking



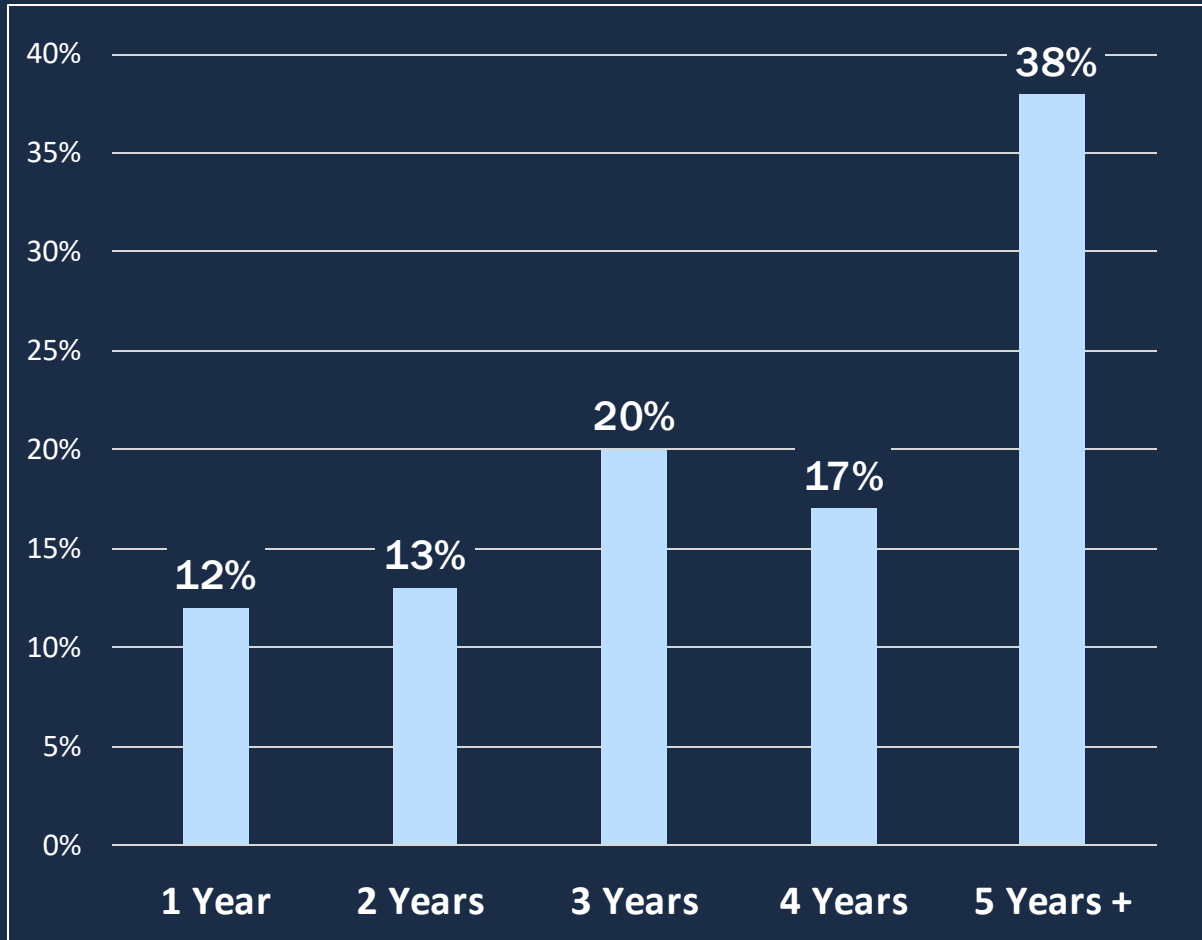
FY23 Grant Ranges

77% of Core Institute grants were larger than \$250K



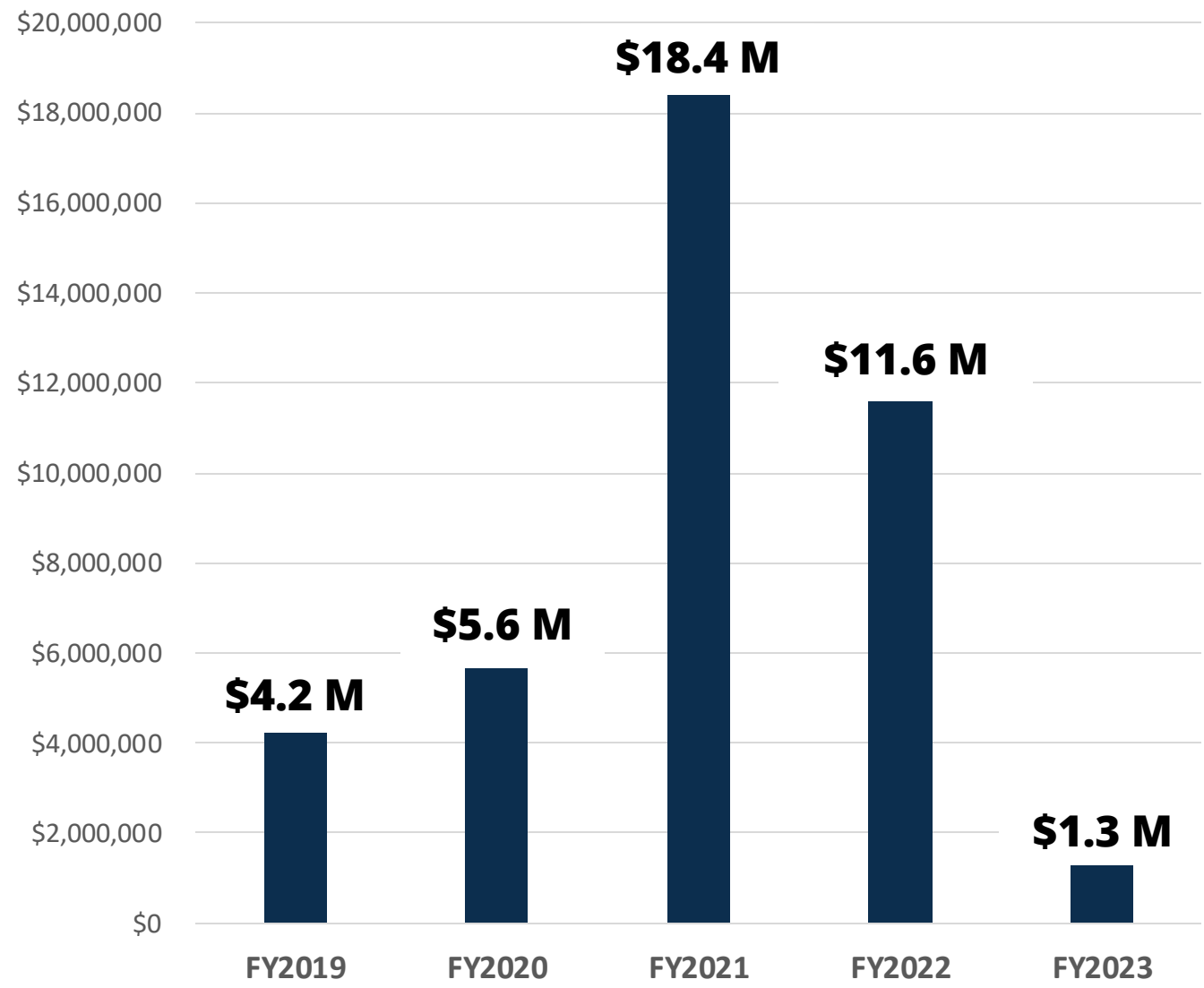
FY23 Grants Tenure

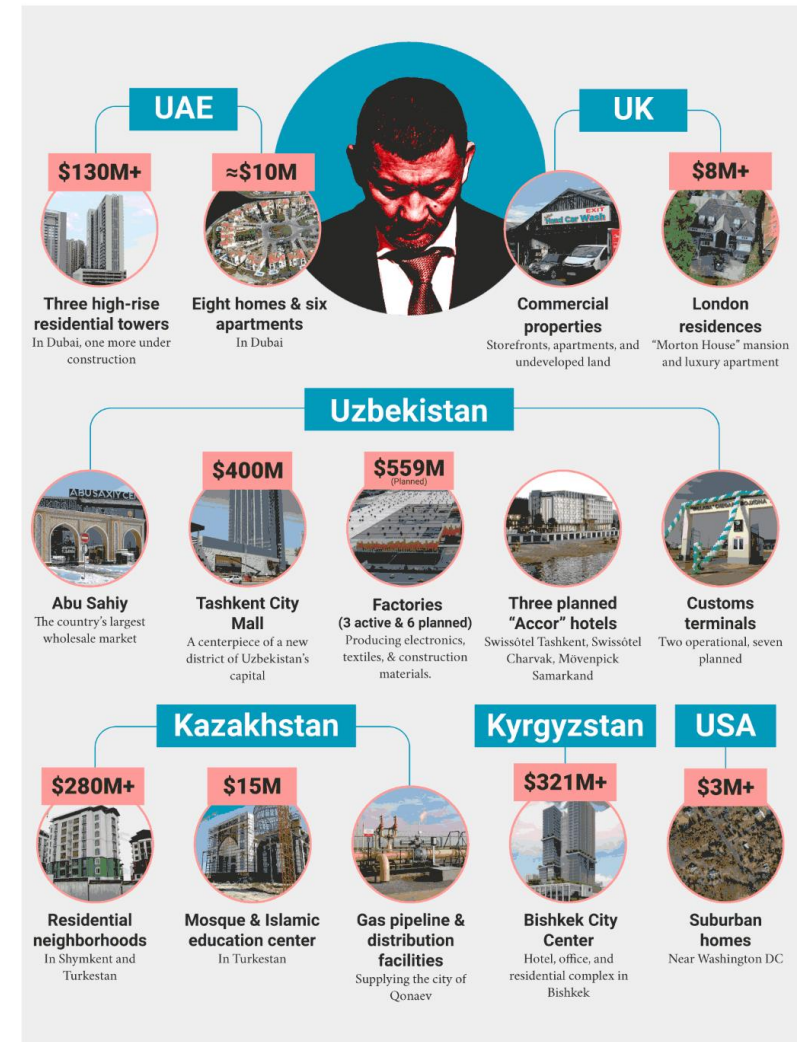
